ALUMNI FEEDBACK CURRICULUM ANALYSIS REPORT 2018-19

Feedback of 195 alumni was collected during the academic year 2018-19. The result of the responses received from the alumni is analysed and the details of the same is as under:

- Out of total 195 alumni 76 (38.97%) rated that the adequateness of the courses offered in the program is excellent, 88 (45.13%) as very good, 28 (14.36%) as good, 2 (1.03%) as an average and remaining 1 (0.51%) as poor.
- 63 (32.31%) rate the sufficiency of syllabus content to bridge the gap between academia and industry as excellent, 116 (59.49%) opined that is very good and remaining 12 (6.15%) were of the opinion that is good, 1 (0.51%) as an average and remaining 1 (0.51%) as poor.
- 74 (37.95%) of alumni rate the curriculum is in relation to the current professional standards thus excellent, while 63 (32.31%) believed it is very good, 51 (26.15%) believed it is good, 4 (2.05%) believed it is average and remaining 1 (0.51%) as poor.
- 82 (42.05%) of the alumni were of the opinion that the skills acquired from the curriculum to face the industry challenges/requirements is excellent, 69 (35.38%) said it is very good, 40 (20.51%) opined it is good, 2 (1.03%) rate is as an average and remaining 1 (0.51%) as poor.
- 72 (36.92%) of the alumni rated the design of the courses in terms of extra learning or self-learning is excellent, 72 (36.92%) as very good, 46 (23.59%) as good and 3 (1.54%) as an average.
- Training and placement cell is getting ample placement opportunities for students, thus 75 (38.46%) rated it excellent, 80 (41.03%) as very good, 37(18.97%) as good and 2 (1.03%) as an average.
- The competence and support offered by the teachers is rated excellent by 82 (42.05%) alumni, while 65 (33.33%) rated it as very good, 46 (23.59%) as good and 1 (0.51%) as an average.
- The institute's support and contribution for the overall development of students is rated excellent by 82 (42.05%) alumni, while 75 (38.46%) rated it as very good, 32 (16.41%) as good and 4 (2.05%) as an average.

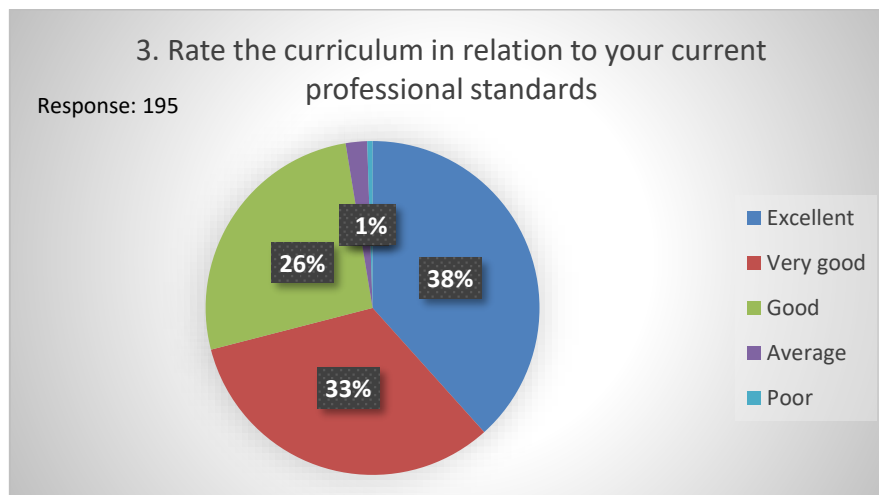
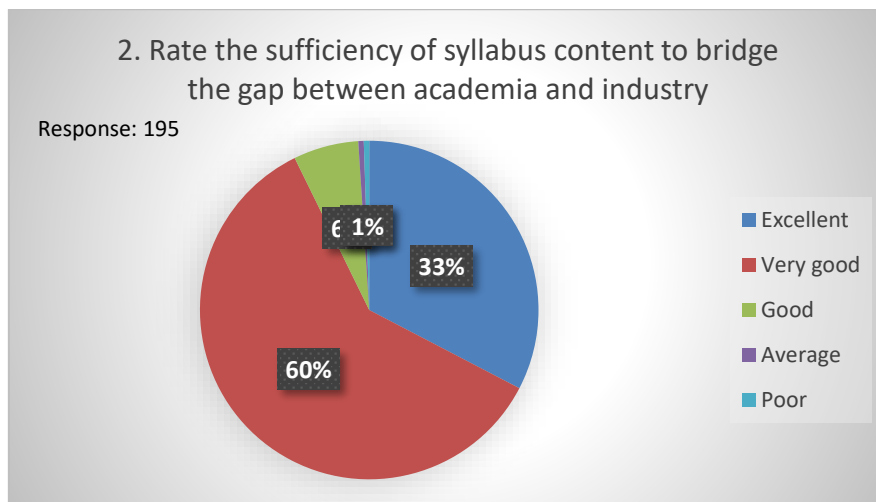
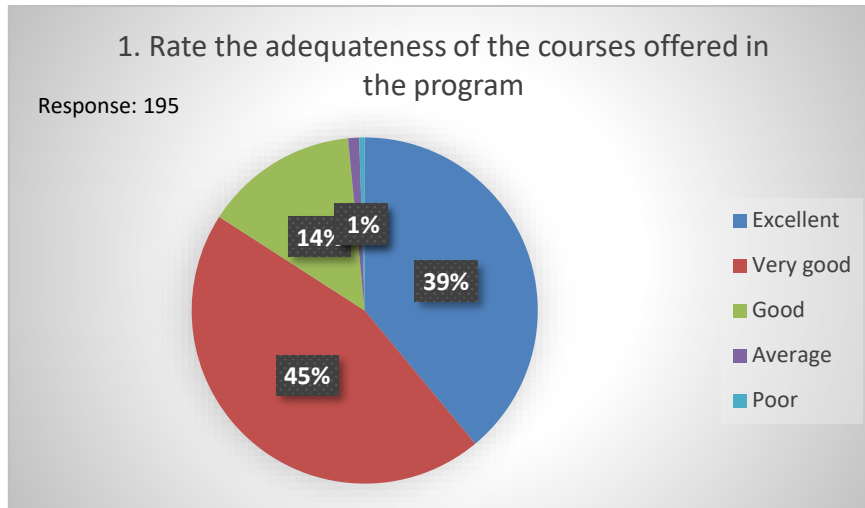

4. On regular basis suggestions and inputs will be taken with regards to emerging trends in various areas and the same will be incorporated in syllabi & curriculum.



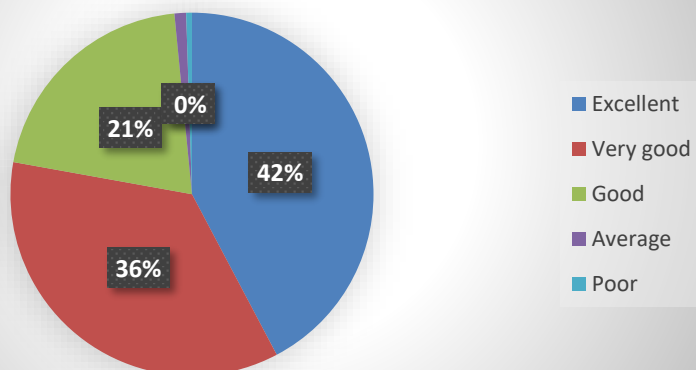

Alumni Feedback Analysis 2018-19



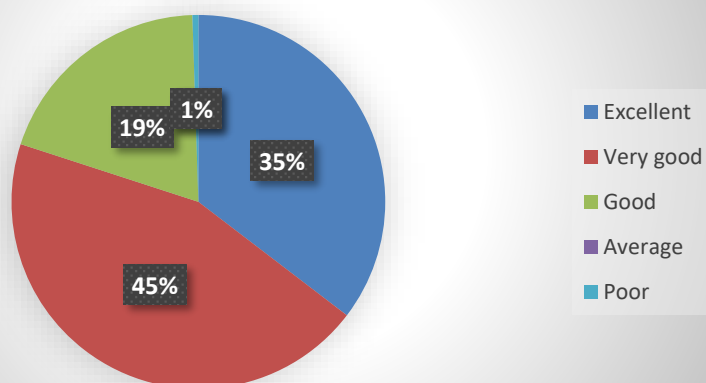
4. Rate the skills acquired from the curriculum to face the industry challenges/requirements

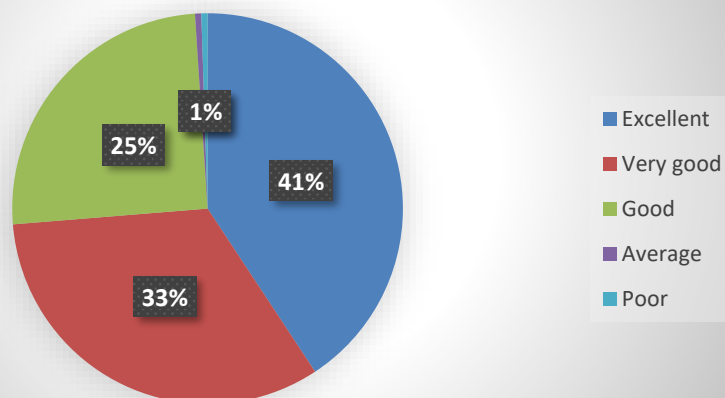


5. Rate the institute's laboratory and equipment adequateness for practical exposure

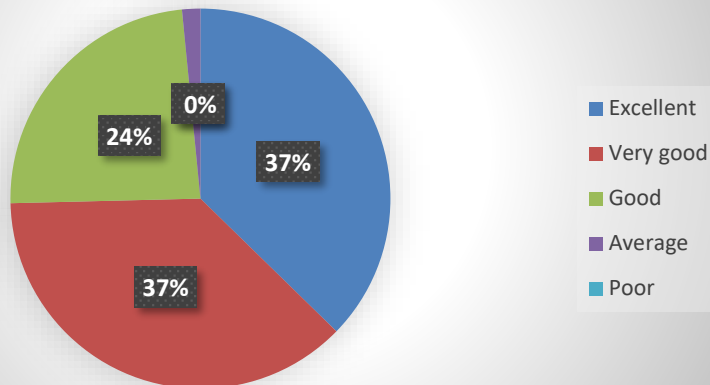


6. Rate the offering of electives in relation to technology advancements



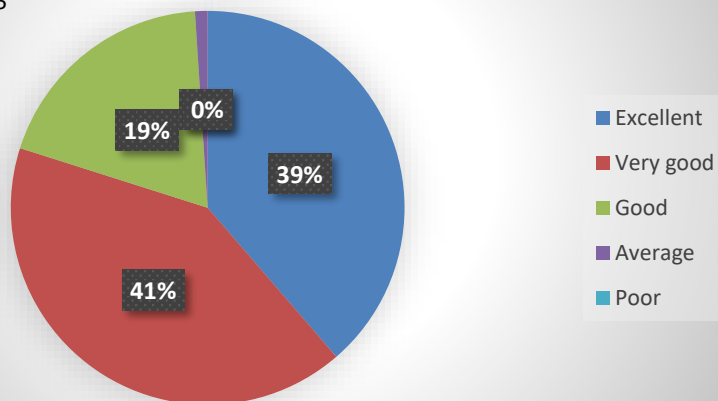
7. Rate the design of the courses in terms of extra learning or self learning

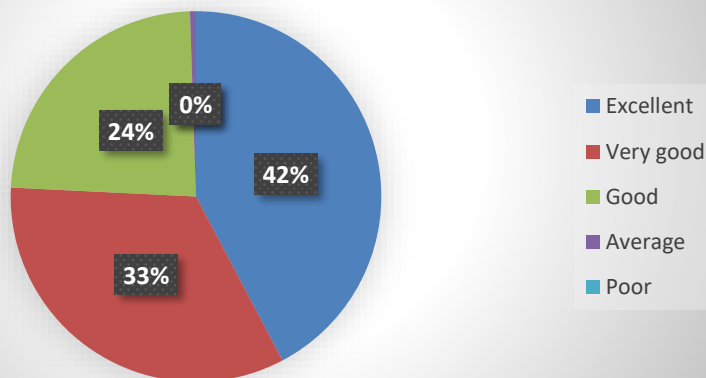
8. Rate the training and placement cell in getting ample placement opportunities

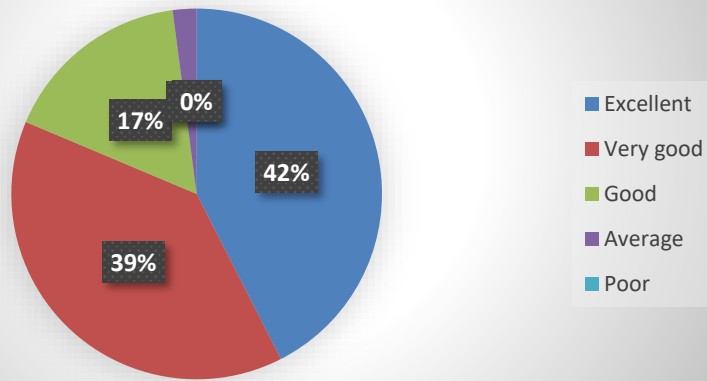
